SCHOLARSHIPS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS ATTENDING A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE IN CALIFORNIA WHO ARE INTERESTED IN PURSUING CAREERS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

CCMF is offering two (2) scholarships annually in the amount of \$1,500 each to graduate students interested in pursuing careers in the local government.

Scholarships will be limited to direct college expenses, such as tuition and books. Scholarships may be paid to the recipient directly or to the educational institution, at CCMF's sole discretion.

The scholarship is not limited to a specific area of academic study. It will be awarded to those who best demonstrate an interest in a career in local government.

Application submittal requirements are as follows:

- 1. Provide a cover letter indicating the educational institution you are attending (or will be attending), the number of educational credits attained to date (if any), current GPA, degrees awarded (if any), colleges and universities attended (if any), and your contact information (including email address).
- 2. Submit a 750 word, or less, essay explaining why you are interested in a career in local government, the type of local government work you would like to pursue upon graduation and any educational/work/volunteer experience you have undertaken in pursuit of this type of career.
- 3. Provide two reference letters from those who can speak to your interest in pursuing a career in local government.

Submittals must be made by August 2, 2013, in order to be considered for a scholarship.
